

## Wednesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>

The buses will make its stops at the following places:

- Latham (Latham Farms, Sam's Club) 6:30 am
- Oneonta (Oneonta Bus Lines) 6:45 am
- Amsterdam (Thruway Park&Ride) 7:00 am
- Binghamton (Chenango Bridge Park&Ride) 7:45 am
- Syracuse (Liverpool UMC) 9:00 am
- Victor (Walmart Supercenter) 10:15 am
- Buffalo (Walden Galeria Food Court) 12:00 pm
- Dunkirk/Fredonia (Dollar Tree, Ex 59) 2:00 pm

Lunch will be at the Walden Galeria Food Court in Buffalo, NY at Exit 45 around noon. (Lunch is on your own – not included in the price). Pick-up in Dunkirk at 2:00 pm. We will stop at the Ohio Rest Area around 3:30 pm.



Then on to our hotel for the night. We will be staying at the Amish Door Inn at the Village. We'll have an Amish meal in the Banquet Hall around 7 pm. After we get checked in, you can take advantage of the indoor pool, hot tub and fitness room, or just relax after dinner.


## Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup>

Start your day off with an Amish Continental Breakfast.

One bus will be leaving very early for those who want to attend Ubuntu. You will get to the Columbus Convention Center as soon after 9:00 am as possible. The first hour will be a worship service, and then you will be leaving for your service. At that point you can also get registered for the conference.



The second bus for those not interested in attending Ubuntu will have a more relaxed day. You will have the morning to visit the Bakery and Gift Shop at the Amish Door Village. Then on to Warther Museum for a tour of the museum, the workshop, the gardens and will include a catered luncheon. We will arrive at the Convention Center in time for you to attend the Public Action Meeting and get registered for the conference.



We should all arrive at the hotel around 5:00 pm. You'll have time to unload, settle in, and relax for a bit. At 7:00 pm, we will head for dinner somewhere in Columbus.




After dinner, we can relax in the pool and hot tub or turn in early. We will all be staying at the Drury Inn and Suites, which is within walking distance of the Columbus Convention Center where the conference is being held. From 5:30 – 7:00 pm each day, you can enjoy the 5:30 Kickback featuring free hot food and cold beverages. There is also free hot popcorn and soft drinks available in the lobby from 3-10 pm. There is free wifi throughout the hotel.

## Friday/Saturday, May 18–19<sup>th</sup>

A Hot Breakfast will be available from 6:00-8:30 am. Opening Worship begins at 9:00 am. I have been promised it is going to be a bigger and better opening worship than even before.



The early registration fee is \$295 with a November 30, 2017, deadline. After that date, regular registration fee is \$330. **The Power of Bold** will include Worship and Plenaries infused with music and performing arts, quality Workshops & riveting Town Hall Meetings with important leaders, Action opportunities and Experience Hall with educational immersion experience. This fee includes two healthy lunches. Dinner each night will be on your own.



Because the Drury Inn is within walking distance, there will not be transportation available from our buses. However, there will be a looping shuttle to other parts of the city if you plan to do any shopping, eating or touring outside of the Convention Center.



## Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup>

A Hot Breakfast will be at the Drury Inn from 6:00 – 8:00 am. We will load luggage onto the buses at 8:30 am before we leave for the Sunday Morning Worship Service. The service is scheduled to be done by noon.

Then it's back to New York State. We will stop for a quick lunch along the way (on your own). We will get to Dunkirk around 5 pm, to Walden Galleria at 6 pm, and then we will head for dinner at the Top of the Falls Restaurant overlooking the Canadian Falls. You will be able to see the Canadian Falls from Terrapin Point, walk to Luna Island which separates the American Falls and Bridal Veil Falls.



We'll check in to the Holiday Inn & Suites Niagara Falls. Those who are interested will be able to take the bus to see the spectacular fireworks over the Falls at 9:30 pm. By 10:30 pm, we'll be back to the hotel for the night.

## Monday, May 21<sup>st</sup>

Breakfast will be at the Holiday Inn & Suites Niagara Falls. After loading our luggage into the bus, we will head to Tonawanda for a tour of Herschell Carrousel Museum. See



a large carving shop where 50 to 75 carvers worked, a woodworking shop, a paint shop, a storage area, an upholstery shop, a machine shop and a roundhouse in which carousels were assembled and tested before shipping. And then take a ride on the famous carrousel.

We will stop for the Buffet Lunch at Pizza Hut around noontime. Drop off in Victor will be about 2:45 pm, drop off in Syracuse will be around 4:00 pm. We will get back to the Binghamton/Amsterdam areas around 5:30 pm and we'll end the trip in Latham/Oneonta before 7:00 pm.



### **IMPORTANT:**

**Please keep in mind that this bus trip is for lodging and transportation to and from the conference. You are responsible for registering for the conference on your own.**

### **ADDITIONAL COSTS TO YOU:**

You will be on your own for the following:

- Wednesday Lunch at the Walden Galleria Food Court
- Thursday Lunch, Amish Village and Warther Museum if you do not attend Ubuntu (additional \$25 with registration)
- Sunday afternoon at the Food Court
- There will be a collection for the driver



(NOTE: cost is based on 30 people per bus; if less than 30 people, the cost will be increased by \$10-25, depending on how many go. If less than 20 people are interested by the deadline, the bus (or trip) will be cancelled.

CANCELLATIONS: after April 16<sup>th</sup>, you will forfeit your \$50 deposit. After May 1st, you will forfeit the entire cost of the trip.
