In our Upper New York Conference, Mission u is a "cooperative school", sponsored by both Conference United Methodist Women and the churches of our Upper New York Conference. We welcome women & men and, in the case of the Cazenovia venue, children and youth.

We offer opportunities for study and fellowship in three different venues, each held on a different weekend in the summer. Each venue has its own special flavor.

At Mission U, we grow in understanding of the mission of the church in the current world context as we "learn together for the transformation of the world". The three studies offered each year cover three aspects: spiritual growth, geographical and social issues.
