Lunch will be at the Walden Galleria Food Court in Buffalo, NY at Exit 45. (Lunch is not included in the price). Or plan to bring a bag lunch with you. There will also be a rest stop near the Ohio border, but only vending machines are available.

Dinner will be at the *Der Dutchman* Restaurant, featuring an Amish-style meal known for its roasted and pan-fried chicken, real mashed potatoes and a full hot buffet. Visit the Amish-style bakery for homemade breads, pies and cookies after dinner. Reservations have been made at a hotel right across the road, the Quality Inn Suites and Conference Center in Belville, OH.

THURSDAY, March 28th

After a hot Buffet Breakfast, we will head toward a tour of the **Matthew 25: Ministries** where we have 2014. The work of Matthew 25: Ministries helps the victims throughout the United States and around the volunteers, goods are processed at the 168,000 square-

foot Processing Center in Cincinnati, Ohio, and then shipped overseas via forty-foot seagoing containers and by semi-trailers to the poor in this country as well as disaster victims.

From there, we will go to the **Ark Encounter**. Lunch will be at the Buffet at Emzara's Kitchen at the Ark. The Ark Encounter features a full-size Noah's Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Spanning 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high, this modern engineering marvel amazes visitors young and old. Ark Encounter is a world-class theme park featuring the most authentic full-size replica of Noah's Ark in the world. Travel back in time on a mile-long scenic bus ride and ascend in view of the massive Ark. The two-by-two animals can all be seen at the Ararat Ridge Zoo.

Dinner will be at *Sonny's BBQ* in Richmond, KY. Arrangements have been made to stay overnight at the Country Inn and Suites in London, KY.

FRIDAY, March 29th

After a hot breakfast buffet at the hotel, we will travel to the Red Bird Mission in Beverly, KY. We will tour the facility in the morning and then have lunch at the cafeteria at the Red Bird Mission. The Red Bird Missionary Conference is the most comprehensive mission of the United Methodist Church in the United States. The Red Bird Missionary Conference is in ministry with Appalachian families living in the coal region of southeastern Kentucky. Its goal is to minister to the whole person by addressing spiritual, physical, educational and economic needs. Historically, this region has been one of high unemployment and lack of opportunity. The mountains cause isolation making basic life services difficult to reach. In the rural areas, it can take an hour to drive to basic places like the grocery store, the bank, or the hospital. Industries are very few in this area. Therefore, many people are left unemployed or are forced to travel extensively to work. Even with new roads and better



transportation the seclusion the mountains create still lingers, leaving many people isolated from work and basic services. The Red Bird Missionary Conference helps ease the need and the isolation through its churches and mission institutions. The churches are working to teach and train local leaders, as well as to provide long term discipleship. Church and outreach workers work diligently with the children through camp and youth groups. They provide Bible studies for their adults as well as fellowship activities.

After lunch at the Red Bird Missionary Conference, we will drive through the Lexington Cemetery, where (hopefully) the cherry trees will be in full bloom. You will have your choice of a relaxing dinner at the *Old Country Cracker Barrel*, *Applebees*, *Steak 'n Shake*, *LongHorn Steakhouse* or *Famous Daves*. This meal will be on your own. Overnight arrangements have been made at the Holiday Inn Cincinnati Airport.



SATURDAY, March 30th

After a hot breakfast at the hotel, it's on to the **Creation Museum**. The state-of-



the-art Creation Museum allows you to venture through biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium, petting zoo, and much more. The history of the Bible vividly comes to life at the world-class Creation Museum. As you enter the Time Tunnel, you'll be transported back 6,000 years to the dawn of time as you begin your walk through biblical history. You'll encounter a realistic Garden of Eden, animatronic Noah, flood dioramas, and stunning video displays throughout your journey. Other exhibits include a fascinating insectarium, sculpted dinosaurs of all kinds in the Dino Den, a full-size Allosaurus skeleton, and much more.

Lunch will be at the Jade Buffet in northern Cincinnati.

Then we will head north to the **BibleWalk, a life-size wax museum** in Manfield, OH, that brings God's Word to life. "*In the beginning was the Word and the Word was made Flesh*" begins your 60-minute journey into the life, death, resurrection, ascension, and ends with Christ seated on His Throne at "*the Great White Throne Judgment*." This tour also features one of Madame Tussaud's famous Last Supper re-creations.



Dinner will be right there at the Bible Walk. We will be having a Jewish Passover Celebration Meal with communion. During a portrayal throughout the meal, one will experience the Miracle of Passover as recorded in the Old Testament and will be introduced to the Passover Lamb as recorded in the New Testament.

Reservations have been made to stay at the Hilton Garden Inn in Twinsburg, OH.

SUNDAY, March 31st

After a full hot Breakfast Buffet, we will head back to New York. We will have our own church service right on the bus. Please let me know if you would like assist with putting the service together. If the weather cooperates, we will stop for a quick visit to Lake Erie at Presque Isle State Park, with lunch at the *Golden Corral* in Erie.

We should arrive back at the Walden Galleria around 3:00 pm. We'll get into Victor at about 5:00 pm and into Syracuse around 6:00 pm. There will be a stop at a Rest Area for dinner. We should arrive in Amsterdam around 8:45 pm and back to Latham at 9:30 pm.
